## Preserving Your Quilt

It is always best to vacuum or spot clean your quilt with a damp cloth rather than to launder your quilt.

If you must launder,  
please remember to hand wash  
only using a mild detergent.

Do not dry-clean. Chemicals used  
in the dry-cleaning process are very  
harsh and can damage delicate  
fibers in your quilt.

Expect some bleeding and fading.  
This is a normal result of laundering  
your quilt.

To store your quilt properly,  
stretched across a bed is best, but if  
it stays folded, remember to refold it  
in different directions periodically  
to keep the quilt from developing  
permanent creases.
